General

- This rider is complementary to the contract and must be signed by the PRESENTER.
- Subject to change as the show evolves.

Show Description

In this powerful, theatrical solo co-choreographed with Emily Gualtieri, David Albert-Toth is dancer, actor and magician in one. Endowed with an atypical virtuoso physicality, he explores intimate paradoxes through movement, text, and magic. The piece unfolds on an Italian-style stage, with curtains creating infinite blackness for a few moments of illusion.

1. Stage Dimensions

- Minimum: 25' deep x 45' wide (7.6m x 13.7m)
- Minimum grid height: 20' (6.1m)
- Stage floor must be level, smooth, unobstructed.
- Please note that these dimensions correspond to the full size performance. It is possible to adapt the performance to a specific venue. Contact us for more information.

2. Venue Technical Plan & Rider

Presenter to provide, 6 weeks in advance:

- Accurate to-scale CAD/Vectorworks drawings (plus PDF) of floor plan, grid, rigging, elevations, seating.
- Full venue information: equipment inventory, loading dock, dressing rooms, etc.

3. Front of House

- 60 minutes, no intermission.
- House opens ≤15 minutes before show.
- No latecomers admitted.
- Post-show talkbacks must be agreed in advance.
- Program notes supplied electronically by COMPANY.
- Additional promo displays subject to discussion.
- Performance includes brief nudity.

4. Masking

- Italian or German masking acceptable.
- Required:
 - Upstage black curtain
 - Main house curtain
 - Black Marley dance floor + tape (provided by Presenter)
- Performer requires:
 - Complete and unobstructed access from the side wing to behind the upstage black curtain
 - Room for a quick change in the side wing (table, chair and light)

5. Set

Provided by Company

- 2 x MYLAR Rain curtain (22'W x 19'H each) SEE REFERENCE
- White tissue-paper confetti
- 3 small fans
- Magic trick accessories

Provided by Venue

- Lift or ladder to access ceiling
- 1 free-standing fan (see reference photo)
- 1 black chair (see reference photo)
- Pipes for rigging (as required)
- Tape, rope, rigging materials





6. Rigging

- Overhead grid system or fly bars/beams with cheeseboroughs, pipes, rigging points, tape.
- Must be safely accessible.
- Grid/pipes should be able to move up/down for scenography.
- Details confirmed in advance with COMPANY.

11. Dressing Rooms & Hospitality

- Clean, ventilated dressing room with:
 - Shower, toilet, disinfectant gel, box of surgical masks
 - o Reserved for dancer + authorized personnel only
 - Clean towels
- Hospitality appreciated:
 - o Fresh fruit, cereal bars, chocolates, nuts
 - Water, coffee/espresso with sugar, milk, honey
 - Assorted teas
 - Microwave, dining area with utensils/plates/cups

- If stage is open to public prior to performance, provide warm-up studio.
